One of the most dramatic changes to the American workplace in the past 100 years is the role of women In much of early-American society, relatively few women entered the labor force In 1950, about one-third of women ages 16 and over were in the labor force; the proportion rose to 60 percent by 2000 and is now just over 58 percent (See figure 3)
