APA Style uses parenthetical, author-date citations. After a quote, add parentheses containing the author's name, the year of publication, and the page number of the work. For quotations that are on one page, type "p." before the page number, and for quotations that start on one page and end on another page, use "pp." as in the examples below.

If an item has no author, start the citation with the article title. When an article has one to seven authors, all authors' names are cited in the References List entry. When an article has eight or more authors list the first six authors followed by three spaced ellipse points (...), and then the last author's name.

A note about online sources: The APA 6th edition requires a Digital Object Identifier (DOI) or the home page URL for articles from a database. If you find an article on the "open web" (that is, you found it using a search engine such as Google), you need the full URL of the article.

When there is no author your in-text and parenthetical citations should begin with the first couple words of the title and include the year of publication. When citing books, videos, brochures, journals, reports, etc. italicize the title. When citing web pages, journal article titles, or chapter titles use quotation marks around the title.

Instead, the Publication Manual, Sixth Edition states that "for substantial reference works with a large editorial board, naming the lead editor followed by et al. is acceptable" (p. 184). In other words, you can cite either all of the editors' names or just the first one followed by et al.
