Turn your mask into the jackal-headed god, Anubis. Cut long, pointed ears out of cardboard to look like short rabbit ears. Glue them to the mask at the temples. Glue a paper cup to the front of the mask to create a long, doglike snout and papier mache it and the ears to blend into the mask.

Cut a 1-inch (2.5-centimeter) wide strip of craft foam, long enough to go across the forehead, from one edge of the mask to the other. Secure the strip to the forehead using masking tape or hot glue. The strip should be level with the tops of the ears. 4

When finished, glue the face to the cardboard and cut it out using a pair of sharp scissors. Then use glue or a stapler to attach the ears to the top of the mask. Use the hole punch to make a hole on each side of the mask at its widest point.

Educator How-to: Make an Anubis mask! | BEYONDbones

1 Draw a circle on the plate. Place a large paper plate with the bottom side facing up. To create an opening for the neck, find a round object to trace (about 4½ to 6 inches in diameter). Place it at the center of the paper plate and move it upwards until it is about an inch from the top edge of the plate.

Cut a newspaper into strips approximately 1 inch wide. Dip the strips into the paper-mache glue and begin to cover the cardboard head and ears. Cover both the front and back with the paper strips. Aim for at least three layers of the paper.

How to Make an Anubis Mask | eHow

The Department of Health recommended the use of two pieces of 100% cotton fabric in mask construction, like that of a tea towel, cut to a size of 12 inches by 6 inches for a standard adult size. Other materials needed include a needle and thread or sewing machine, scissors, and pins or clips to keep the fabric being sewed in place.

How to make a homemade fabric face mask to help prevent ...

Check you have the general outline of your face imprinted: nose, lips, corners of your eyes and cheekbones. Use a marker and trace around your eyes (it might be good to follow the bones around your eye socket) for where you want to place the eye holes in your mask. Also, trace around anything else you want cut out.

How to Make a Mask out of Tin Foil and Tape: 10 Steps

Cut it so it partially wraps around the sides, and use the cut piece to go under the bottom of the head as shown. Use three nuts and bolts or pop rivets to attach it to the cardboard, you want this to be fastened solid. Glue a piece of metallic gold material under the hair in case anything shows through.
