If you have taken the medication aide test for the adult care homes, it does not qualify you to pass medications in a nursing home. Individuals who wish to work as a Medication Aide in a Nursing Home must contact the N.C. Health Care Personnel Registry at 919-855-3969 or the N.C. Board of Nursing at 919-782-3211 for information and specify that you are interested in working in a nursing home.
